Guided rides will include a fast pace ride, gaited/medium paced ride, or slow ride.

Reservations must be received by October 30. Event is held rain or shine. Weekend plans subject to change. No Refunds unless TEC determines it must be canceled for conditions beyond its control.

Cost: \$60 for the weekend includes non-electric camping fee, 2 breakfasts and 2 dinners; or \$45 for Tuckahoe Equestrian Center members; \$30 for non-riding campers; \$15 for children 10 and under; \$25 for non-camping Saturday riders (includes Breakfast and Dinner). TEC membership applications are available on our website www.tuckahoeequestriancenter.com and will also be available the day of the event. A La Carte available.

Accommodations: There is plenty of room for non-electric camping using your own portable corrals. Quiet generators are welcome. 20 amp and 30 amp Electric Hookups, plus six indoor stalls and ten outside pipe corrals are also available with additional fees on a <u>first reservations received basis – no call in</u>. Hi-lines accompany the 30 amp electric sites at no additional fee. There is water for horses around the grounds, but no water hookups for trailers/campers.

All Fires need to be kept in Fire Bowls. No open fire pits.

All dogs must remain on leash in camp and kept in a manner so not to be a nuisance. No dogs allowed on trails, in the clubhouse, or in the designated picnic area around the clubhouse.

FROM THE NORTH: Take US Route 301 south. Turn left onto Route 304 at blinker light. Go 4.1 miles and turn right on Route 481. Go 2.0 miles and take the first left into the park on Crouse Mill Road. After 1.0 mile turn right at the lake and follow to parking lot

FROM THE WEST: Take US Route 50 across the Chesapeake Bay Bridge (staying on RT. 50 when 50 and 301 split) follow Route 50 to Route 404. Turn left at the light and go to first light at Queen Anne, MD. Turn left onto route 309. Go 1.0 mile and turn right onto Horseshoe road. Go to stop sign and turn right and follow to the parking area.

FROM THE EAST: Take Route 404 west through Denton, MD and follow to the stop light at Queen Anne MD. Turn right on route 309 and go 1.0 mile. Turn right on Horseshoe road. Go to stop sign and turn right and follow to the parking area.
